Abstract

Previous research has documented the decline in rates of cycling to school, and considered social factors that contribute to this decline. This paper examines fifty years of complementary changes that underpin the social factors. These include increased volume and speed of motor traffic, changes in urban and road design, legal and quasi-legal changes, and changes in bicycle technology.
